St. Ignatius of Antioch Sports Hall of Fame

Class of 2006



LOUISE FURJANIC

Louise is the Physical Education teacher at St. Ignatius of Antioch Grade School, a position she has held since 2000. This quiet, unassuming, and friendly person has a very impressive athletic and professional background! In her adolescent years at St. Thomas More School in Brooklyn she played basketball and softball. Back in the late 60's, girls high school basketball was not available at most schools, so Louise played CYO and AAU Ball, becoming a very good player. She continued her playing career at Ohio State University and in addition to being a starter for the Lady Buckeyes for three and a half years, she was also named Co-Captain her senior year. In a major accomplishment, Louise was a member of the 1974 U.S. Handball Team and as such participated in qualifying games in Iceland, Germany, and Denmark in preparation for the 1976 Olympic Games in Montreal, Canada. Unfortunately, the U.S. Team lost to Japan in the qualifying tournament. Louise was also an accomplished softball player, earning a starting position on the 1974 OSU team. She played in the Amateur Softball National Tournaments in Jacksonville, FL and York, PA with 4th and 9th place finishes respectively. After her playing days, Louise got involved in the Administrative side of Athletics. From 1977 to 1980 she was the Head Coach in Women's Softball and Basketball at Cleveland State University. She also was the Head Basketball Coach at Erieview High School and was selected as 'Coach of the Year' while at Erieview in 1982. Louise is also a referee in basketball and volleyball (31 years). She has been selected to work State Championship games at OSU, thus becoming one of the few who both played *and* refereed on the OSU hardwood! As an educator, Louise had been a teacher at Christ the King in Cleveland, St. Bartholomew in Middleburg Hts, and Erieview Catholic in Cleveland before joining us here at St. Ignatius. Louise, we are very proud of you and welcome you to the St. Ignatius of Antioch Sports Hall of Fame!



PATRICK McDANIEL

Patrick is a life-long member of St. Ignatius Parish. He came from a large family, growing up on W. 98th St., and still lives in that same house with his wife Bonny and their children – sons Patrick and Nicholas, who are 6th & 4th grade students at St. Ignatius of Antioch respectively, and their newest addition, nine month old daughter Delaney. Pat graduated from St. Ignatius in 1980 and has the distinction of being the third member of that class to be enshrined in our Sports Hall of Fame. He was the fastest boy in the school at that time. He played basketball on the old Providence team, winning a Championship in 1977, and while a member of the IBA Villanova team, coached by Jack Natale, Pat led the league in scoring in his 8th grade year. While in high school at Holy Name, although Pat played four years of basketball, he found his real love in cross country and track. Pat continued his education at the University of Akron and played basketball for the Zips under Coach Bobby Higgins. Pat has a ring earned for the '86 Zips team that qualified for the NCAA Basketball Tournament. Pat loves running and has participated in several marathons and 'Ultra Marathons' (100 miles). A few years ago, he ran in a 'Super' Marathon (200 miles), stopping after 156 miles only because he tore ligaments in his ankle. Pat has coached basketball at St. Ignatius for 18 years, during which time he coached Holy Cross to one championship and took his 'Cinderella' Crusaders squad of '04 to the championship game! Pat also started Cross Country *and* Track programs for our school about four years ago! These teams are showing measureable improvement and it won't be long before he brings a championship to St. Ignatius! Aside from sports, Pat is also active with the Parish. He is a member of Parish Council and as such is very involved with his St. Ignatius. Pat, we proudly welcome you 'home' to the St. Ignatius Sports Hall of Fame.



BRIAN K. SMITH DDS, MD

If you did not know him, you would not suspect that Brian Smith was one of the better ball players coming out of St. Ignatius of Antioch. While in grade school, Brian played football for Bob Lungo's Niagra's Purple Eagles in the IFL and played for Coach Emil Schuster's Detroit squad in the IBA. While here at St. Ignatius, Class of 1974, Brian played with some of the best athletes to go through our school - Bernie Clark, Tony McDaniel, Dan Reiser and Don Szymczak just to name a few.

Brian, an excellent student, went on to St. Ignatius High School and fought his way to a starting position on the Wildcat team under Head Coach Marty Chambers. Brian relied on his speed and terrific court sense to overcome the taller opponents he had to face. He was one of the better point guards in the city.

Brian was focused as to his goals in education, wanting to enter the medical field. He continued his studies at the College of Wooster, graduating in 1982. While there he found time to play roundball for the fighting Scots while meeting his demanding academic schedule.

Brian continued in his goal of a medical career studying at the North East Ohio Medical College. After graduation, he interned at Metro Hospital and began his practice in 1994. Brian specializes in Oral & Maxillofacial surgery and practices out of his office in Lakewood, OH. He also is busy with speaking engagements to those in the medical field. In spite of his very busy schedule, Dr. Smith has remembered us at St. Ignatius. He has made worthwhile donations to our school in the computer technology area and has somehow found time to assist in our IBA Program. When Dr. Smith was notified of his most deserved election to our Hall of Fame he somewhat apologized for not being able to help more this year because of his demanding schedule. *Dr. Smith, no apology expected!!* We are proud of your accomplishments, not only as the professional that you are but as the man you have become in giving back to this community. Welcome to the 2006 Class of the St. Ignatius of Antioch Sports Hall of Fame!



BRIAN WYPASEK

Brian is a 1985 graduate of St. Ignatius. While attending school here, Brian played basketball and baseball. Brian grew up on Almira Avenue and remained within the Parish until this year, when he and his wife bought a home in Elyria. While at St. Ignatius, Brian played basketball for the Papal Guard of the Vatican City League under League Director Emmet Donelon and on Fordham Rams Varsity squad for Coach Al DeWerth. Brian went on to Cleveland Central Catholic and was a member of the school's golf team. Brian spent several years toughing it out at night school, but his perseverance paid off. He obtained his Accounting Degree from CSU in 2002. He works in the Accounting Division for Oster Homes in Lakewood, OH.

Brian has been volunteering his time and talent in coaching at St. Ignatius for 21 years. He started coaching in the Vatican City League as an assistant while in high school, and he was selected to be Head Coach of the expansion Dayton Flyer team in 1993. In 1997 and 1998, Brian coached the Flyers to back to back IBA titles. Several of his players went on to play high school ball.

Brian also coached in the Girl's League, assisting his wife Debbie, winning a title for Notre Dame in 1995. He is currently the Head Coach of our Boys High School CYO team, having success in that League as well. His 1999 squad won the St. Pat's high school tournament and were the City champs, thus qualifying for the CYO State Championships in Dayton, OH. His 2000 team repeated as St. Pat's champs, and the 2001 Team won the City title and again qualified for CYO State Championship play in Toledo, OH. This year, Brian and Dave Emery have *again* coached the CYO Boys high school team to a spot in the City Championship game to be played **tomorrow at 1 pm at the Cudell Rec Center**. The team would love to have your support at the game!

Besides his CYO high school team, Brian is coaching two IBA teams this year, as he has done several other times, and his Bearcats team, which was undefeated in the regular season, is playing in the Antioch League Championship game today.

Even though he has moved to Elyria, Brian plans on continuing to give back to the youth by coaching in the IBA. Congratulations, Brian, and welcome to the 2006 Class of the St. Ignatius of Antioch Sports Hall of Fame.

Athletes Fair Play Code

- ◆ I will participate because I want to, not just because my parents or coaches want me to.
- ◆ I will play by the rules and in the spirit of the game.
- ◆ I will control my temper since fighting and disrespect can spoil the activity for everyone.
- ◆ I will respect my opponents.
- ◆ I will do my best to try to be a true team player.
- ◆ I will remember that winning isn't everything. Having fun, improving my skills, making friends and doing my best are also important.
- ◆ I will acknowledge all good plays or performances by both my teammates and my opponents.
- ◆ I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions, show them respect and understand they have given their time to be with me.

Coaches Fair Play Code




