

BRUCE BETHANY

Bruce began his involvement with our IBA program in the early 1990's as an assistant in our Vatican City League, where his sons Mike & Tommy played. Bruce was passionate about the game, always looking for ways to improve the skills of his players. He often held parent/player meetings, showing films, and expressing his goals and plans for the season. Success was earned by Bruce and his players on the Sistine Chapel Eagles of the Vatican City League. From 1991 through 1997, they won four Championships and were runners up twice. Several of his players went on to play high school ball, but more importantly, he helped instill the need of goals and having a "can do" attitude in the boys he coached. His players were fortunate to play for Bruce, and were enriched by that experience.

Bruce is employed by Ford Motor Company in Avon Lake. He and his wife Carol, a St. Ignatius of Antioch graduate, are the proud parents of two grown sons. Mike (an engineer), along with his wife Kara and son Sean, await the birth of their daughter, Paige. Tom, single, currently works for a law firm while pursuing his law degree from The Ohio State University.

FRANK EVANS

Frank is being posthumously inducted into our Hall of Fame. His accomplishments in life were many and noteworthy.

Frank, a 1945 graduate of St. Ignatius of Antioch grade school, was a star of their football, basketball, and track teams. His CYO Basketball Team won the Championship in 1945. Frank attended Benedictine High School, and was a standout athlete there. His 1948 Bengal football team won the city title over South High, 7-0. Frank played fullback alongside Chuck Noll. (Chuck later became Head Football coach for the Pittsburgh Steelers, in addition to being inducted in the NFL Hall of Fame.)

From high school Frank went to Toledo University for one year, after which he enlisted in the Navy. His Navy career lasted until 1991. While in the Navy Reserve, Frank also attended and graduated from The Ohio State University, obtaining a degree in Journalism. During time in California, he began teaching and coaching at a Catholic High School, and met his future wife, Dorcas, whom he married in 1962. From there they settled in Denver, CO with their two children, Ann and Neil, along with one grandchild.

Frank taught school and became Head Football Coach at Cathedral High School in Denver, while continually encouraging the youth in the area to 'be the best they could be, and they would be successful in life.' His wife said "He just thought kids needed a chance."

Frank passed away June 21, 2008. One can see Frank's success came from following his own advice. We are pleased and proud to include Frank in our IBA Hall of Fame.

ANTHONY SIDOTI

Anthony may be one of our youngest inductees, but he has accumulated a long list of accomplishments earning him the honor of induction.

Anthony also attended St. Ignatius of Antioch grade school. While here, he participated in the IBA program, playing for the Cougars, Cardinals, and Notre Dame. Anthony went on to high school at St. Ed's. During that time, he played for our CYO High School Team, which qualified for the State CYO Championships in 1994 and 1995.

Also while in high school, Anthony began his eighteen year IBA coaching career, beginning with two years as an Asst coach for the Cardinals, after which he became their Head coach for the next twelve seasons. Since 2004, Anthony has been Head coach for Georgetown, in addition to finding time to assist with the Bearcats and with the CYO High School team.

Anthony proudly has helped with the development of 6 straight MVP players from his Cardinal squads. He also coached two championship 5th grade St. Ignatius traveling teams in the West Side Youth Parochial League in Berea.

Anthony works for the City of Cleveland with the Cleveland Public Power Group. He and his wife, Capri, reside in Westpark with their two year old son, Anthony Jr.

Congratulations, Anthony, and welcome to the Class of 2009 IBA Hall of Fame.


