GEORGE "Butch" COLBERT

George is a 1953 graduate of St. Ignatius grade school, and was a classmate of Neil Huber, also a 2010 inductee into our Hall of Fame. George was a gifted athlete who played multiple sports while here at St. Ignatius, but basketball was his favorite. After grade school, Butch (as he was called by his friends) went on to attend St. Ignatius High School.

He played basketball there, making the varsity squad as a sophomore. After his sophomore year, George left St. Ignatius High and transferred to West Tech (or, as we call it, 'St. West Tech'). There he continued his basketball career as a starter for the Warriors.

After graduation, George studied for and became a Cleveland Firefighter. He worked hard at his career and retired with the rank of Captain.

George and his wife, Maryanne, recently celebrated their 50th Wedding Anniversary. They have two children and three grandchildren. Maryanne has a longstanding relationship with St. Ignatius Grade School as a teacher and Assistant Principal during here career here. George's brother-in-law, Eddie Dwyer, is a retired high school beat writer for the Plain Dealer, and is also a member of our Sports Hall of Fame, having been inducted in the Class of 2002.

MIKE HARRIS

Mike began his basketball career at St. Mary's in Berea, where he played five years of CYO basketball. Upon entering Berea High School, he became an assistant coach under his father at St. Mary's. During his five years there he learned the importance of teaching team work and the fundamentals of the game. Mike became involved with the IBA 18 years ago as a referee, in which he refereed numerous championship games. Eight years later, Mike began coaching in the IBA. In his ten years as a coach, he has made five Championship Game appearances, winning three times – once in each division he has coached – with the Antioch League Knights, the Vatican City Papal Guard Lions, and the Boy's Varsity Seton Hall squad.

Mike not only put in a lot of hours as a coach, but also gave a considerable amount of time figuring out the schedules for each league, plus scheduling referees for the games each weekend. During IBA's annual October registration, he put in many hours calling players from previous years to remind them it was time to sign-up. And, as if Mike has not given enough of his time to our IBA program, two years ago he began coaching our newly formed High School CYO JV Basketball team.

Mike has been employed as a US Mail Carrier for the last 14 years. Mike became a member of St. Ignatius parish after marrying his wife of 32 years, Denise, a graduate of St. Ignatius Grade School. They have three children – Jeff, Stephanie, & Brad – all former IBAers themselves. Six months ago, Jeff and his wife Jennifer were blessed to bring Mike and Denise their first grandson, Brennan, destined to become an IBAer before you know it!

We are proud to have Mike as a member of the Class of 2010 IBA Hall of Fame.

NEIL HUBER

Neil is a St. Ignatius of Antioch parishioner. He graduated from our grade school in 1953. He has had a noteworthy athletic career throughout his playing days in the 50's and early 60's. Neil excelled in all sports offered while playing CYO here. His track, football, and basketball teams all won City Championships. He went on to St. Ignatius High School, where he earned All Ohio Honors in football, as well as national recognition in that sport. He also ran track and played basketball under legendary coach John Wirtz.

Neil earned an athletic scholarship to the University of Cincinnati, and played football for Coach Sid Gillman, who became a renowned coach at San Diego in the AFL & NFL. Neil was also part of the basketball squad that won NCAA titles in 1961 and again in 1962 over Ohio State. He was a teammate of the 'Big O' – NBA Hall of Famer Oscar Robertson. In 2000, Neil was elected to the St. Ignatius High School Hall of Fame. Neil and his wife Ann reside in Westlake. They have six grown children and 13 grandchildren.

We are pleased to induct Neil as a member of the 2010 Class of the IBA Hall of Fame.

Cleveland student on her way to NBA's All-Star Game for the Fit Challenge

Selena Benz's basketball skills are taking her to Texas.

The 14-year-old award-winning basketball player will be on an all-expenses-paid trip to the NBA All-Star Game in Dallas this weekend and will participate in the NBA Fit Challenge.

The NBA Fit Challenge, sponsored by the asthma medication Singulair, hopes to encourage children to stay healthy while having fun. Youths ages 14 and younger will participate in five events ranging from basketball chest passes to jumping rope. Selena is one of two girls in her age group competing for a trophy.

"I first heard about the NBA Fit Challenge by going to Google and checking out NBA.com," said Joseph Benz, Selena's father. "I really like these programs because it keeps the kids busy."

Selena, an eighth-grader at Charles A. Mooney school in Cleveland, has been playing basketball since she was in the fourth grade and is familiar with the NBA youth challenges. In 2008, Selena beat out 23 other girls in Orlando, Fla., to become the national Junior NBA/Junior WNBA Skills champion.

Now Selena is preparing for her trip to Dallas.

"I feel happy and nervous," Selena said. "I feel happy because I get to go on vacation for free, and nervous about the competition and playing in front of a lot of people."

The honor roll student is a Cleveland State University ball girl, retrieving balls for the women's basketball team, making sure referees have plenty of water and keeping the floors clean.

Selena plays the role of an assistant coach for her father's basketball team at Our Lady of Good Counsel School in Cleveland. She also travels with an Amateur Athletic Union girls basketball team, a program that gives the best players in the

country an opportunity to show off their skills.

The oldest of four girls lends a hand at home by helping her sisters with their homework as well as their game. Selena and her 9-year-old sister, Jalecia, often play basketball together. Jalecia is a Junior NBA winner, being named the fastest girl in Ohio in her age group in 2008.

Selena wants to play college basketball after she graduates from high school.

"Maybe UConn [the University of Connecticut]," she said. "I like Maya Moore," a forward for the Huskies.


