

PETER CAMPBELL

Pete is very dedicated to our Basketball Program. Almost every Saturday from December to mid-March, you will find Pete running up and down the court as one of our referees. Pete enjoys this sometimes ungrateful task, and he is respected for what he does. You may see him in the morning here at Saint Ignatius, and later that same day find him at various gyms as a CYO referee.

Pete has been involved with our Basketball Program for over 20 years, and he does know his basketball! He coached the St. Peter Cougars starting in 1984 when he was a freshman at St. Edward's High School. He coached the Cougars for six seasons, winning three back-to-back Vatican City League Championships (85-86-87). During his time leading the Cougars, Pete also coached three Vatican City League MVP's: Marty Williams, Pete Latkovic, and his younger brother, Patrick Campbell. In 1990, he moved up to the Boys Varsity League as head coach of St. John's Red Storm.

A 1994 graduate of Cleveland State University, Pete also made the Viking Varsity Basketball team his senior year – as a walk-on!

Pete is active in coaching basketball at St. Ed's. He was head freshman coach for three years in the mid 90's, and is still assisting the squad, a job he has held for some ten years or so. He was also assistant varsity coach in 1998 when St. Ed's won the State Title over it's arch rival St. Ignatius High. One of our own, Pete Latkovic, was a starter on the state championship squad.

Pete's family has ties to St. Ignatius of Antioch, His mother went to our school, and later was married here. His sister Colleen plays volleyball in our Women's League. His brother Patrick is owner of PJ McIntyres Pub & Grill by Kamm's Corner, so you often see Pete at that establishment. Both Pete and Patrick are also proud members of the renowned Michael Flatley's 'Lord of the Dance'!

We are grateful for Pete's involvement with our Youth Basketball Program. He too is a welcome inductee to the Saint Ignatius of Antioch Hall of Fame, Class of 2011.

JACK SMITH

Jack is a lifelong member of Saint Ignatius of Antioch. He grew up on West Blvd, and graduated from our school in 1973. While in grade school, he participated in all available sports - baseball, basketball for Jack Natale's Villanova Wildcat I.B.A. squad, and football for the I.F.L. Niagra's Purple Eagles, coached by Bob Lungo.

A Saint Ignatius High School 1977 graduate, Jack has remained close to his roots at Saint Ignatius Parish. He began his coaching career in the I.B.A. while still a freshman in high school, as an assistant with Chris (Fuzzy) Jarus for the then Cincinnati Team in the Vatican City League. Jack then moved up to the Varsity League, heading Holy Cross, winning a Boys Varsity Championship with the Crusaders in the mid 80's.

Jack's high school teams were his pride and joy. He was coach of our CYO high school team, working first as an assistant to Jack Natale from 78-82, then taking over as Head Coach in 1985. His 1985 & 1986 teams were City Champions, and the 1986 CYO squad placed 3rd in the State Championships. In the 90's, he assisted Al DeWerth with the high school team. Jack is currently coaching the Knights in our Antioch League.

Jack, who is single, lives in Fairview Park. He attends daily mass at St. Ignatius of Antioch. Retired from a long career with the U.S. Post Office, he is currently director of Absolute House, located on Broadway at the old Holy Name High School campus. He directs programs for AA & drug rehabilitation for some 70+ men.

We welcome Jack to the Saint Ignatius of Antioch Hall of Fame, Class of 2011.

DANIEL E. URBAN

Dan is also a lifelong member of Saint Ignatius of Antioch Parish, having participated in all the sports programs, and graduating from the elementary school in 1971.

Dan has been actively involved with the parish for many years, most noteworthy with the youth of our parish and community. At Saint Ignatius, Dan has been most generous in volunteering with our Young Adult and Athletic Programs. For the past 16 years, Dan has been heavily involved with the I.B.A. Sports Program. He coached basketball for a few years in the Antioch, Vatican City, and Varsity Leagues – assisting Coach John McHugh with winning the Boys Varsity Championship for Villanova in the late 90's. He also acted as a site director in our CYO Boys Volleyball League. However, the apple doesn't fall far from the tree. While years ago, his mother Margaret used to cook for our Parish house, Dan is now mostly recognized as the "Chef of the I.B.A." He is in charge of the concession stand operations, although it's more like a restaurant than a 'typical' concession stand. Bacon and eggs, donuts, bananas, and bagels for the early crowd on Saturdays. For lunch it's "soup to nuts," including his famous IBA Dogs, burgers, nachos, fries, onion rings, etc. Dan is the king of his domain, and you'd better say "please" and "thank you"!

Dan has also been long involved with the West Denison Baseball League as a past board member, commissioner, umpire, groundskeeper and pretty much everything else in between. He is currently certified with the Ohio High School Athletic Assn as a Baseball and Fast Pitch Softball umpire.

This youth advocate, who is battling some personal health issues, loves the kids and his parish. He still lives in the house he grew up in on Almira Avenue. He is married to Pam and has three children – all following in their dad's footsteps as players and now coaches in the I.B.A. program. Son Dan currently coaches the Vatican City Eagles, while Parker is attending Kent State University and assists with Marquette when he is in town. Daughter Maggey, a junior at Saint Joseph Academy, also coaches the Lady Wildcats and plays for the girl's CYO squad.

Mr. McCafferty coached the Marquette basketball team for thirty years. Mrs. McCafferty was also very involved with the school while their children, Bernie, Dennis, Brian, Geralyn, Mary Beth, and Noreen attended Saint Ignatius Grade School.

To honor the memory of their parents, the McCafferty Children have established an Annual Scholarship Award to be applied toward the recipient's family share of tuition for a Saint Ignatius of Antioch student. This award will not necessarily be given to the best athlete or the best student. The McCafferty children will review input received from Coaches, Teachers, and the students themselves. They will then choose the recipient(s) whose criteria they feel best honors and represents their father's years of coaching, and their mother's focus on education.

Athletes Fair Play Code

- ◆ I will participate because I want to, not just because my parents or coaches want me to.
- ◆ I will play by the rules and in the spirit of the game.
- ◆ I will control my temper since fighting and disrespect can spoil the activity for everyone.
- ◆ I will respect my opponents.
- ◆ I will do my best to try to be a true team player.
- ◆ I will remember that winning isn't everything. Having fun, improving my skills, making friends and doing my best are also important.
- ◆ I will acknowledge all good plays or performances by both my teammates and my opponents.
- ◆ I will remember that coaches and officials are there to help me. I will accept their decisions, show them respect and understand they have given their time to be with me.


Coaches Fair Play Code

- ◆ I will be reasonable when scheduling games and practices, remembering that young people have other interests and obligations.
- ◆ I will teach my athletes to play fairly and to respect the rules, officials and opponents.
- ◆ I will ensure that all athletes get equal instruction, support and opportunities.
- ◆ I will not ridicule my athletes for making mistakes or performing poorly. I will remember that young people play to have fun and must be encouraged to have confidence in themselves.
- ◆ I will remember that young people need a coach they can respect. I will be generous with praise and set a good example.
- ◆ I will make sure that equipment and facilities are safe and match the athletes' ages and abilities.
- ◆ I will obtain proper training and continue to upgrade my coaching skills.

Fans Fair Play Code

- ◆ I will remember that young people play sports for THEIR enjoyment, not to entertain me.
- ◆ I will not have unrealistic expectations and will understand that doing one's best is as important as winning. I understand that ridiculing an athlete for making a mistake is not acceptable behavior.
- ◆ I will respect the official's decisions and will encourage all participants to do the same.
- ◆ I will respect and show appreciation for the coaches and understand that they have given their time to provide sport activities for our young people.
- ◆ I will encourage athletes and coaches to play by the rules and to resolve conflicts without resorting to hostility or violence.
- ◆ I will show respect for my team's opponents because I realize there would be no game without them.
- ◆ I will not use bad language and will not harass athletes, coaches, officials or other spectators.
- ◆ I will always show good sportsmanship since young people learn best by example.
