## **HALL OF FAME – CLASS OF 2013 INDUCTEE**

### **Pete Latkovic**

Pete is a great addition to the St. Ignatius of Antioch Hall of Fame. While at St. Ignatius, Pete played in the IBA Vatican City league for St. Mary Major as a 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup> and 5<sup>th</sup> grader, then in Catholic University league better known as the Boys Varsity League. During his 5<sup>th</sup> grade year he was named MVP of the V.C. league and repeated that distinction twice more in the varsity league playing for Notre Dame under coach Steve Hanigosky (St. Ignatius HOF 2000), winning the league title Pete's 8<sup>th</sup> grade year. Pete also played for St. Vincent DePaul in the CYO league and was one of the best players in the city of Cleveland.

Pete went on to St. Edward's high school, where, as a freshman he played on the JV squad, only to be moved up to the varsity in late season. As a sophomore, and again as a junior, Pete came off the bench as a '6<sup>th</sup> man' on teams that went deep into the state playoffs. Pete's senior season was a year to remember, as now starter Pete helped the Eagles to their finest hour, winning the school's first (and only, to date) state basketball championship. That team finished 26-1, was ranked #1 for most of the year, and received high rankings in the USA Today poll, and other national ranking polls.

After high school, Pete attended Owens College in Toledo for two years. While there he led the team in three point shooting both years. Pete returned to Cleveland and continued his education at CSU, graduating in 2003. While at CSU, he was named head freshman coach at St. Edwards, and was also an assistant for the varsity. (He then taught science class at St. Ed's after graduating from CSU). Those varsity teams were successful gaining Final Four appearances. Later, Pete returned to the Toledo area as a math teacher and assistant varsity coach for Toledo Central Catholic (working under his former college coach from Owens College). Those TCC teams were a Toledo power, reaching the Final Four during one of Pete's years there.



Pete returned to Cleveland and is still close to the game he loves. He works as a sales rep for Spaulding, selling sports equipment and team apparel to schools, while occasionally refereeing some games in the adult leagues. Pete is married to his college sweetheart, Kate, and is living in North Olmsted with their two-year-old son Pete 3<sup>rd</sup> – or "3 Pete" as they call him. Kate is also involved in athletics as girls volleyball coach for Fairview high school. Pete is keeping his options open, as he may get back into coaching should the occasion arise.





# *McIntyre Center - I.B.A. Gym Floor*

It's hard to believe, but more than one year has passed since our new gym floor was installed by Williams Sports Floors of Akron, Ohio. We have received nothing but positive, excellent comments regarding it's quality and beauty. The school children and our I.B.A. program have enjoyed many recreational hours in this state of the art facility. We no longer have the moisture and buckling problems that plagued the old floor. The new installation has a monitored ventilation system to alleviate that former problem.

Many of our visitors, former players, and graduates have stepped up and made a financial donation of \$50 or more to our campaign "\$50 for 50 Years", established in 2012 in celebration of 50 years of the I.B.A. More than \$8,000 has been raised to date, with donations still being made to this ongoing campaign. The new floor was at a cost of more than \$60,000, which included new baskets, wall pads, and other improvements in our McIntyre Center. The \$8,000 has assisted in helping cover some of the costs involved.

## **HALL OF FAME – CLASS OF 2013 INDUCTEE GEORGE HOHMAN ('54)**

George came to St. Ignatius as a 7<sup>th</sup> grader when his family moved from St. Colman to St. Ignatius parish in 1952. George tried out for the CYO football team and was a pleasure to have, per coach Bernie Heneghan (St. Ignatius HOF 2001, CYO HOF 2007). George recalled that, as he was over 6' tall and had a large shoe size, coach Heneghan did not have football spikes that would fit George. So, knowing George's family couldn't afford them, Coach himself went out and bought George a brand new pair. That deed is *still* remembered fondly by George when he recalls his playing days at St. Ignatius.

As a 7<sup>th</sup> grader, George made the varsity squad and that team won the league and city CYO championships. He also played on his 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> grade basketball teams, which, as leading scorer both years, he led to city championships! Track was also one of his loves and he excelled there, too. He ran hurdles, never losing a meet until the city CYO championships, where he placed 3<sup>rd</sup>.

George could not play football as an 8<sup>th</sup> grader as he could not meet the weight limits per CYO rules. Nevertheless, both Cathedral Latin and St. Ignatius high schools recruited George for football, track & basketball. George chose St. Ignatius over Latin, where he excelled in all of those sports and was a two-year starter in football and basketball. His BB teams won the West Senate league his junior and senior years, losing to Latin in the City Championship in 1957, and to East Tech in 1958. (Those two schools were 'state powers' in those years.) George was named to the All Scholastic team his senior year. Another starter on those teams was Neil Huber (St. Ignatius HOF 2010). The Iggy football teams were powerhouses in those years (as they are today) winning many Senate titles, and were proud to have had George and Neil as part of those successful squads.

After high school, George was recruited for football, attending the University of Dayton. During his freshman year, he injured his knee and unfortunately his playing days ended. George eventually transferred to Kent State, finishing his education there. He is retired as a sales representative for Kinetico Inc, a manufacturing firm. He and his wife Tally are "snow birds", recently returning to their Ohio home in Sagamore Hills, where they are members of St. Barnabas parish. George and Tally, who retired from her nursing executive position at Marymount Hospital after a 40 year career, have two grown children, George and Kimberly, along with four grandchildren.

We welcome you, George, to the St. Ignatius of Antioch Hall of Fame, Class of 2013!





# Saint Ignatius of Antioch Sports Program



The Saint Ignatius sports programs go back many years, probably as far back as the school itself. During the 1940's and 1950's, the school was one of the largest in the Greater Cleveland area with students numbering more than 1,500. Sports programs offered were varied: track, football, baseball, and basketball were CYO (Catholic Youth Organization) sports for the boys, and the girls participated in basketball and cheerleading.

During the 1960's, the parish formed a large intramural basketball program for its school children. With school busing and the flight to suburbia in the 70's and subsequent drop in enrollment in our school, it became difficult for the league to continue. With the approval of our pastor, a program was implemented whereby children who formerly could not participate (because they were not in

our school) would be eligible to join the program. This new endeavor brought more youth to our leagues.



Well-known as the IBA (Ignatius Basketball Association), the program now consists of 27 elementary teams and three high school teams with 270 participants from 40 different area schools. We probably have the largest community program in the city of Cleveland.

Both boys and girls play in the Saint Ignatius leagues, which include the Antioch League for third and fourth grade boys and girls; the Vatican City League for fourth and fifth grade boys; the Catholic University League, named after the Catholic college, one boys league and one girls league.

The parish sports program has established a Sports Hall of Fame, which currently has 51 inductees.

Saint Ignatius Athletic Director Patrick McDaniel, '80 is assisted by 46 coaches and many volunteers in running this large program as well as boys and girls CYO volleyball, track and cross country and intramural track and cross country.

Although the sports program no longer sponsors CYO football and baseball, students who wish to participate in those sports can play for neighboring parishes. Saint Ignatius continues to welcome students from other schools to participate in the sports programs that are offered here.



