

Our Coach, Our Friend....

On June 24, 2015 the I.B.A community was greatly saddened by the sudden passing of one of our youngest coaches, Dave Woods, at the age of 26.

Dave was a player every coach would love to have had on their team. While he may not have been the best player on any of his teams, he would always give 100% effort and out-work his fellow teammates, thereby making them, and the team as a whole, better. This is also how he lived his life, giving it 100% and getting the most out of it.

Dave started his I.B.A. career as a 3rd grader playing for the Lions in the older format of the Vatican City League, then Notre Dame in the Boys Varsity League. Dave made Second Team All-Stars in his 5th and 8th grade years. In Track and Field, Dave held the school record in the 800 meters, with a time of 2.42, for over five years. He accomplished this not by being a gifted runner but by out-working all other runners. Dave graduated from St. Ignatius of Antioch in 2003.

Dave went on to St. Ignatius High School, graduating in 2007. While at St. Ignatius he ran cross country and played Volleyball, in which he lettered. He graduated from Kent State University in 2012 with a bachelor's degree in Business Administration. At Kent State, Dave joined Tau Kappa Epsilon fraternity where he immersed himself in helping younger members to become men of character. As a member of the fraternity Dave served as Rush Chair, Treasurer, President and Hegemon. He also attended Leadership Academy, which helped him educate new recruits and prepare others for leadership roles within the chapter.

Starting his I.B.A. coaching career while in the 8th grade, Dave became an assistant coach to Tiffany Jarus for the Antioch League Knights. Dave & Tiffany then moved on to coaching the Eagles of the Vatican City League. During this time Dave & Tiffany brought their teams to the championship game three times, winning one League Championship title. Dave stepped away from coaching while attending college, but upon his graduation returned as the head coach of the Cougars along with his assistant coaches Andy Stawicki, and future wife Katie Hutchinson.

Upon graduation from Kent State, Dave started work with Buckeye International. It was not long after that Dave's hard work paid off and he received a promotion which had him relocated to Indianapolis, Indiana in January of 2015. While in Indiana, Dave married his longtime girlfriend Katie on May 29, 2015.

Dave, as you can imagine, gave 100% to his coaching efforts as well. Upon his promotion to Indiana for work, Dave had his team practice changed from Thursday to Sunday, so he could drive back to Cleveland to coach on Saturday, practice on Sunday and drive back to Indiana Sunday after his team's practice. Dave was also assistant coach with Fordham under Bob Smith.

It is in honor of Dave's commitment to hard work and unselfishness that we are renaming the Vatican City League's M.V.P. Award the "Dave Woods Memorial Award".

Robert Emmett "Monk" Donelon

Tonight we honor Emmett "Monk" Donelon, who has given so much over many years to St. Ignatius Parish and its Athletic programs. "Monk" was a nickname given to him many years ago by his close friends, and even today he is still affectionately referred to as such. It was in 1957 that the new gym was completed as a finishing touch for the recently built school that housed, at that time, over 1,500 students. Monk, who was recently married to his bride Alice, had moved into their home on Fidelity Avenue and began their family which would later grow to ten children.

Emmett loved his parish and volunteered to be a member of an Athletic Board authorized by then Pastor, Msgr. Albert Murphy. Msgr. Murphy was a visionary for the St. Ignatius community, spearheading various projects such as a new school building (1954) and gymnasium. He was also instrumental in the completion of the Bradley house (across the street from the rectory on Ignatius Ave) that was home to over 40 nuns of the St. Joseph Order that served several west side parish schools. Msgr. Murphy, also a member of our Hall of Fame, passed away on Christmas Day 1963.


With the new gym many rules were in effect to assure it stayed in tip-top shape. Players had to have tennis shoes that were not worn outside of the gym. It was mandatory that the showers were utilized and all equipment and uniforms be kept in proper condition. When a non-athletic event occurred, 4x8 plywood sheets were put over the floor to protect it and sawdust was put down for dances when they were held. The students went to "Sock-Hops" (no shoes allowed) to further protect the floor from shoe heel scratch marks. A full time Activities / Athletic Director and Secretary were on staff for the gym and athletic activities.

As a board member, Mr. Donelon oversaw the athletic program that was then part of the CYO establishment. A young man in 20's, he had a vision of the growing school and community. He was concerned that only a select few could participate in the CYO leagues, which were only for the upper grades. With the large enrollment at St. Ignatius he wished to provide an opportunity for all to participate. With that in mind, in 1961 Mr. Donelon spearheaded a program of intramural sports for the 3rd, 4th, and 5th grades. The name of the new league for those younger students was The Vatican City League. All teams were named after places in the Vatican, such as The Papal Guard, The College of Cardinals, North American College, etc. Those same team names still exist today.

Mr. Donelon was also the Founding Father for a new intramural league for the parish high schoolers who were members of the parish Hi Club. This very competitive league had eight teams and was called the Antioch League. Most of our high schoolers went to St. Ignatius, St. Ed's, Holy Name, or – what Mr. Donelon affectionately referred to as – "ST." West Tech. The Hi Club had membership well over 150 students.

All of the Donelon children attended St. Ignatius and all participated in the various sports programs. Several coached at various levels in the I.B.A. after their playing days. Emmet and Alice always treasured their affiliation with St. Ignatius. They were honored at the 2013 Parish Gala with the "Chalice Award", given to those who exemplify our mission in this parish community. The Donelon children, all grown now with families of their own, continue to remember St. Ignatius with their generosity, attending and contributing to our fundraisers. Several have donated services to the needs of the parish, such as asbestos abatement work, repair work to our plaster walls in the gym due to water damage or when an 'errant' ball hit the wall, even donating hundreds of cases of Gator Ade to the gym for us to sell in our concession stand on game days.

We give a heartfelt thank you to all the Donelon's, but especially to Robert Emmett "Monk" Donelon for all he has done for St. Ignatius Parish and its athletics.



St. Ignatius of Antioch Sports Hall of Fame 2016 Inductees

JEFFREY HARRIS

Jeff is a most deserving selectee to the St. Ignatius Hall of Fame, Class of 2016. A 1995 St. Ignatius grade school graduate, Jeff played with the 1990 – 1992 I.B.A. Vatican City League St. Peter Cougars, winning the 1990 league title under then head coach Pete Campbell, a HOF member who continues to give back to the kids of the I.B.A. as a league referee.

Jeff continued playing in the I.B.A. for Marquette Golden Eagles, then moved on to the high school CYO league. He (along with fellow 2016 HOF inductee Andrew 'Drew' Suvak) was part of the strong unbeaten 1999 CYO squad which won the St. Pat's CYO Division A tournament, went on to win the city title and place 3rd in State Championships. When not playing in games, Jeff assisted with keeping books, scorekeeping, and announcing at I.B.A. Championship games along with his father Mike, also a HOF member.

In 2001 Jeff began his I.B.A. coaching career as an assistant on the Papal Guard Lions team under his dad Mike, then moving on to the Head Coach position for the Vatican City League Bulldogs. Assisted by Jamie Martens, David Woods, and younger brother Brad Harris, the Lions were league runner-ups in 2003, 2005, 2008 and 2015, winning the League Championships in 2006 and 2009! Like many I.B.A. coaches, Jeff held dual coaching duties multiple years, coaching the Seton Hall Varsity team to a League Championship in 2005, while bringing them to the league runner-up spot in 2009, 2010, 2011, and 2015. That's quite a tribute to Jeff's coaching abilities. He is very well liked by his players, who have learned some important life lessons under his tutorship.

Adding to his love for the game and the kids he's mentored, he also became a licensed referee, working for six years, including many I.B.A. games during that time.

Jeff met his now wife Jennifer when they were both students at BW. Married in 2006, they reside in Stow, OH, where they raise their two youngsters, Brennan, age 6, and Clayton, 2. Congratulations are in order as they are expecting a 3rd addition to the Harris family this July.

We are proud to welcome Jeffrey Harris to the St. Ignatius Hall of Fame, Class of 2016.

DENNIS KILBANE

In the past Dennis has been a finalist in the HOF election process and we are pleased that he has been nominated and elected to the Hall of Fame Class of 2016.



All told Dennis gave us 15 years of his time and talent as an assistant or head coach in the I.B.A. Needless to say we are very grateful for his contributions to the youth of this neighborhood. It is people like Dennis that make us very proud of the work we do for the children of the I.B.A.

ANDREW SUVAK

Andrew, or Drew as he is known to his friends, is a most welcome addition to the St. Ignatius I.B.A. Hall of Fame. His contributions have and continue to be most noteworthy to ministry we provide to the youth of this neighborhood and community.

Drew, a St. Ignatius grade school grad, played in the I.B.A. Vatican City League for the Papal Guard Lions, then in our Varsity League for both St. John's Red Storm and Dayton Flyers. While on the St. John's squad, the Red Storm won the 1993 League Championship. They were not the favorite in the playoffs, but 'stormed' through them, winning game after game to claim the title. As a starter for the Dayton squad, Drew played for fellow HOF Coach Brian Wypasek, a current I.B.A. League Commissioner.

Drew went on to St. Ignatius High School and played intramural ball while at Iggy. He (and fellow Class of 2016 HOF Inductee Jeff Harris) belonged to the Ignatius Radio Club. The club aired Wildcats home games, including some basketball games which Drew and Jeff had the opportunity to announce for the Cats. Additionally, Drew (and Jeff) played on our high school CYO team, which during his senior year won the 1999 CYO City title, as well as the prestigious St. Pat's championship, where all the cities elite teams played.

While in high school Drew began his coaching career in the I.B.A. He has been coaching for over 15 years, with both the Papal Guard teams of the Vatican City League, and the Seton Hall Varsity League squad. In addition, Drew was also a referee for a few years, working many I.B.A. league games. While still coaching, Drew continued his education, obtaining a degree in Business Administration, and also a Master's Degree from Baldwin Wallace University. He and wife Sheena have been married for six years and reside in Strongsville with their 3-year-old French Bulldog, Apple.

We thank you, Drew, for all you do for the St. Ignatius community and welcome you as a 2016 member to our Hall of Fame.
